Member moorage of vessels is to be approved by the Penticton Yacht Club ("PYC") Marina Manager to dimensional restrictions of the moorage layout. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE ALLOWED. ABSOLUTELY NO LIVING ON BOATS DURING WINTER STORAGE. Docks may or may not be maintained during winter storage. USE AT OWN RISK.

HEATERS. 7.2.1.1.1. The use of portable heaters in boat storage areas shall be prohibited except where necessary to accomplish repairs. initial

7.2.1.1.2. Portable heaters used in accordance with 7.2.1.1.1. shall be used only when personnel are in attendance. initial

7.2.1.1.3. Open flame heaters shall not be used in boat storage areas. initial

INSURANCE

It is understood and agreed that the member will carry his or her own insurance coverage at all times and PYC is not responsible for any loss of or any damage of property or bodily injury claims.

WAIVER OF RIGHTS AN SUBROGATION CLAUSE

It is understood and agreed that the undersigned hereby waives its rights and/or subrogation rights to sue or take any other legal action against PYC from all liability and for any claim for loss or damage by fire and other hazards or caused by any act or neglect on the part of PYC or its employees or members.

CRANING

Craning Fees are charged on a pre-set amount determined by the cost of the crane (per hour) and the average amount of time used & boat length. Longer vessels will be subject to additional billing. Insurance requirements for the craning contractor is a minimum of \$2,000,000 general liability and \$150,000 hook insurance, where the latter covers damage to your boat should loss occur while suspended in the air. Tips for efficient use of the crane:

1. Check the "Schedule" prior to Crane Day for you approximate scheduled time;
2. Allow yourself plenty of time to prepare for craning without missing your scheduled crane time;
3. Enlist the help of family/friends who are familiar with your boat to assist in:
 - (a) Cradle placement/removal onto/from the parking lot;
 - (b) Removal of your boat as soon as it is craned into the water or at the dock for crane out; and
 - (c) General preparation for craning.
4. Have both bow and stern lines hanging overboard prior to craning for handling of your boat once it approaches the water line;
5. Have fenders hanging overboard prior to craning to protect your boat once craned into the water; and
6. Ensure your motor is operational to depart from the craned area.

BOAT/TRAILER/CRADLE STORAGE

I understand and am aware that this a storage area and no staff on duty. There will be no in/out of trailer/cradle once in the storage area until end of the season – as determined by PYC. Maintenance of the property will not be looked after (ie: removal of snow and/or ice, routine repairs etc.) therefore access to the area is at my own personal risk and I agree to abide by the Maintenance Policy in effect at the Penticton Yacht Club ("PYC").

- 1.) Risk in which I assume responsibility waiving any and all recourse against PYC or its insurers;
- 2.) Liability insurance of the above reference vessel is in place in which I assume all responsibility waiving any and all recourse against PYC or its insurers; and
- 3.) All "Terms and Conditions" of the Penticton Marina Moorage Contract remain in force during the duration of the agreement; and
- 4.) Any boat remaining stored in the lot after May 1st, 2022 will be removed at the owner's expense.
