1. RULES

The Race will be governed by the 2025 – 2028 Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The race is open to self-righting racing sailboats and cruising sailboats including white sails.

2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the Registration Form available at pycmarina.com or by emailing pentictonyachtclub@outlook.com. Paper copies will be available at the Marina Office.

2.3 Registrations will be accepted via online Form, email or at the Rusty Anchor - Race Headquarters Friday, Sept 4 from 5:30 - 6:30PM and Saturday, Sept 5 from 8:00 - 8:30AM. Pre-registration is preferred.

3. FEES

Registration fees are **\$190 per boat** and includes 1 Meal Package. **Additional meal packages for crew members are \$90.** Fees will be accepted via the online Form, at the PYC Marina Office or e-transfer @ pentictonyachtclub@outlook.com. Registration fees will also be accepted in person at the Marina Office/Rusty Anchor - Race Headquarters Friday, Sept 4 from 5:30 - 6:30PM and Saturday, Sept 5, from 8:00 - 8:30AM. Pre-registration is preferred.

5. RATINGS

Each boat shall declare its BC PHRF rating at registration. Divisions will be assigned based on registration turnout.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be provided at registration or via email upon request.

7. MOORAGE / RECIPROCAL MOORAGE

Moorage for visiting boats is to be arranged prior to arrival via the online Form or PYC Marina Office (250) 770-2000/pentictonyachtclub@outlook.com.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sept 4 & 5

1. Rules - The regatta will be governed by the 'Rules' as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing.
2. Notice to Competitors- will be posted on the Official Notice Board located next to the gate to the Y dock.
3. Insurance -all yachts must carry valid certificate of insurance, indicating public liability coverage that shall not be less than \$2,000,000.00.
4. PHRF Rating System
 - 4.1 Yachts racing under handicap shall be members in good standing of BC Sailing with a valid 2020 PHRF certificate. Non-members will be provided with a temporary PHRF rating.
 - 4.2 Handicap fleets will race under the PHRF rating **Time on Time** system.
5. Sail Numbers
 - 5.1 All boats shall comply with Appendix G, Identification on Sails
 - 5.2 Yachts with duplicate or missing sail numbers shall notify the RC.
6. Changes to Sailing Instructions
 - 6.1 Any changes made to the sailing instructions will be posted no later than 9:30 am on the day it will take effect.
7. Signals Made Ashore will be displayed on the committee boat.
8. Daily Check – in. There will be no daily check in.
9. Starting Procedures
 - 9.1 The warning signal for the first race of the day Sept5th @ 10:30 am, Sept 6th @ 10:00am
 - 9.2 A boat starting later than five (5) minutes after the start signal will be scored DNS.
 - 9.3 The starting line for all fleets will be between 1 orange inflatable shape and the mast of the RC boat.
 - 9.4 If a boat is subject to RRS 29.1, Individual Recall, or RRS 30, Starting Penalties, the race committee may attempt to hail her sail number and/or boat name directly. No aspect of the hail, including content, timeliness, existence, or failure to hear, will be grounds for a request for redress.
10. Courses
 - 10.1 The diagram included in this package lists the courses & the order in which marks are to be passed or rounded. Course numbers will be displayed on a white board attached to the boom of the RC boat. After a yacht has finished, it must stay clear of yachts still racing.
 - 10.2 The gate consists of the pin end of the start/finish line and the RC boat. When a gate course is being sailed, boats shall sail between the gate marks from the direction of the previous mark and round either the port gate mark to port or the starboard gate mark to starboard.
 - 10.3 From the time a boat rounds the first rounding mark until she rounds the last rounding mark, she shall not cross the start / finish line unless sailing a course with "G" (gate) in the sequence.
 - 10.4 All marks will be rounded to port unless otherwise noted on course map
11. Abandoning After Start
 - 11.1 The Race Committee may abandon a race in progress when a change in the weather conditions has, in its judgment, made the race an unsatisfactory test of skill.
12. Finish- The finish line will be the same line as used for the start.

13. Time Limit -Due to longer courses there will be no time limit. The Race Committee will run most courses based on the 90 min time limit. But may abandon a race at Race Committee's discretion. All Yachts must finish within 30 minutes of the first yacht to finish in their class.

14. Withdrawal -Boats retiring from a race shall inform the Race Committee before leaving the race course.

15. Protests

15.1 Protests shall be written on forms available at the RC boat. Protest shall be delivered there within the protest time limit.

15.2 For each class, the protest time limit is sixty (60) minutes after the RC boat has docked.

16. Scoring -The low point scoring system will apply. One race completed will constitute a series. If five (5) or more races are completed, a boats worst score will be discarded.

17. Awards for first, second, and third places will be presented at the Rusty Anchor - PYC Clubhouse after racing on Sunday.
